Reunion Dates: Our Reunion dates are Wednesday, October 10th through Sunday, October 14th.

The cutoff for hotel reservations and for Armed Forces Reunions is September 7, 2018.

He served in the Navy from 1944-1970 and was commissioned in 1948.

He served on 5 ships; USS Canberra (CAG-2), USS Northampton (CLC-1), USS Stribling (DD-867), USS Stembel (DD-644) and the USS Notable (MSO-460) as its Commanding Officer.

He also served on the Staffs of Commander Destroyer Squadron Seven and Commander Cruiser-Destroyers Pacific.

His final tour was with the Air Force in the Advanced Ballistic Re-entry Systems Division of the Space and Missile Systems Organization.

He retired in 1970 as a Lt. Commander.



Ship's Silhouette Hats


We have Ship's Silhouette Hats in stock. The cost for each hat will be \$20.00 per cap including priority mail postage (cost is up due to postage increases).

USS CANBERRA REUNION ASSOCIATION TOUR DESCRIPTIONS

Thursday October 11 ST. LOUIS CITY TOUR

Enjoy a guided tour of St. Louis. Drive through Forest Park, home of the 1904 World's fair, as well the St. Louis Zoo and several museums. Our first stop is at the Cathedral Basilica to see one of the largest collections of mosaic art. Following a tour at the Cathedral, we will take a driving tour passing by St. Louis University, Fabulous Fox Theatre, Powell Symphony Hall and St. Francis Xavier College Cathedral. You'll stop at Soldier's Memorial, St. Louis' tribute to the men and women who lost their lives in this country's wars. From there, you'll head to Kiener Plaza, located in the very heart of downtown St. Louis with a fabulous view of the Old Court House and the Gateway Arch. You'll have time to enjoy lunch on your own at your choice of a number of eateries including St. Louis Bread Co., Hardee's, TGI Fridays, and Charlie Gritto's. Following lunch you'll continue the driving tour past the waterfront and the Gateway Arch, the tallest national monument in the United States. Take in Laclede's Landing, a revitalized 19th century warehouse district with cobblestone streets and cast-iron street lamps as well as the diverse historic community of Soulard, located just south of downtown St. Louis. It is one of the oldest neighborhoods in the city with homes dating from the mid to late 1800s.

Friday October 12 DANIEL BOONE HOME & MOUNT PLEASANT WINERY

Spend a day in the beautiful Missouri Wine Country, Augusta, MO is America's first designated wine district - three years before Napa, California! On the way to the wine country visit Daniel Boone's Home and Village. Designed by Daniel to resemble his birthplace in Pennsylvania. Daniel and his son, Nathan, began construction on the blue limestone structure in 1803 and completed it in 1810. Daniel and his wife shared the home with Nathan and his wife and their fourteen children until their deaths. Outside the home are the remains of the Judgment Tree, where Daniel settled disputes between white men and the Indians of the Valley. Then it's on to Mount Pleasant Winery, founded in 1859 by the Munch family from Germany. This site was selected because the beauty of the topography reminded them of their homeland. The cellars were built from wood and limestone from the area and were finished in 1881. These cellars are still used today to age their estate bottled wines and their international award-winning ports. The winery offers a calm, friendly environment for your complimentary wine tasting. Then relax on the patio with its majestic views and enjoy a boxed lunch. Bottles of wine may be purchased to compliment your lunch.

Saturday October 13 ST. CHARLES HISTORIC TOUR

Go back in time to the quaint town of St. Charles to experience the charm and beauty of a city that has been welcoming visitors since 1769. Walk around the nine-block National Register Historic District, complete with brick streets, gaslights, and charming restored buildings. Browse through over seventy-five one-of-a-kind antique, craft, gift shops, and over 25 restaurants. Satisfy your palette with anything from St. Louis style BBQ, pizza, and sandwiches to ice cream or old-fashioned candy. Choose your atmosphere too - enjoy a patio setting, historic ambiance, local pub, or coffee house. Consider a tour of the Old Capitol building, dating back to 1821 (small admission fee).
